

The Biannual General Council Meeting of Shri Alakh Sahiba Trust (Regd.) was held today, which got started at 11.30 a.m. with General Secretary's address on behalf of the President, in Mata Roop Bhawani Bhawan, Tirath Nagar, Talab Tillo, Jammu and lasted upto 2.20 afternoon.
